Part Leation, Eligibilities and Scholarship Provisions

1. The program is open to nominated participants on a "first-to-apply, first-priority" basis. Each HFalls allowed to endorse and nominate a maximum of 2 permanent Filipino Instructors-participants who shall be provided free tuition/registration, workshop ID and kits, materials are confificate of participation.
