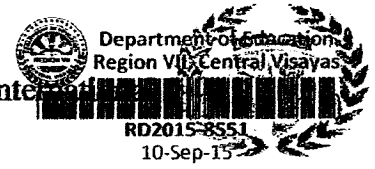

6. address relevant issues and concerns among teachers and guidance counselors across borders.

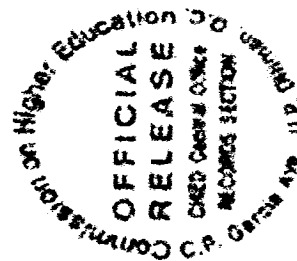
The target participants are guidance counselors, life coaches, teachers, psychologists, educators, policy-makers and researchers nationwide and delegates from other countries.


