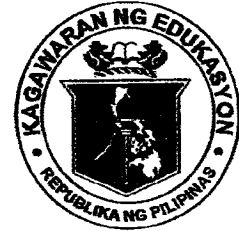

Likewise, the Teacher Advisers will also be conducting a seminar workshop under the management of the CMLI Teacher Advisers' Association of the Philippines, Inc. (CMLI-TAAPI) simultaneously with the student delegates' scheduled activities.

The convention fee is **Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php6,250.00)** for every delegate and teacher adviser to cover expenses for camp accommodation, food, convention kits/materials, handouts, certificates, souvenir program and speakers.

With this in view, may we respectfully request your office, the Department of Education to endorse this event to all private and public elementary schools under your jurisdiction to attend and participate in this unique five-day activities. There is no limit as to the number of delegates an institution may send.


