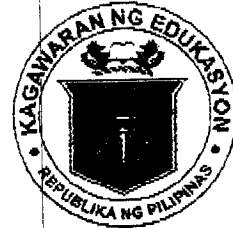

The **Supporting Enabling Empowering Students (SEES)** Teachers' Manual on the Emergency Psychosocial Support for Secondary Students during disasters had been developed by UNESCO in coordination with the Department of Education and in collaboration with the Psychological Association of the Philippines (PAP).
