PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINATION FOR DEPED DIVISION PERSONNEL

1. Infection with the Streptococcus pneumoniae bacteria is a leading cause of serious illness in adults and children. Many strains of this bacteria are resistant to antibiotics. Serious blood, brain and lung infections from this bacteria like pneumonia, meningitis and septicemia are called pneumococcal disease and can be prevented with pneumococcal vaccine.
2. The Department of Health Regional Office 7(DOHR07) through the Regional Director Dr. Jaime S. Bernadas had been kind enough to approve the DepEd RO7 request signed by Dr. Juliet A. Jeruta for pneumococcal vaccine allocation for Regional and Division Office Personnel. Each Division Office will be provided with two hundred (200) vaccines with autolock syringes.
3. This office encourages the Division Office Personnel to avail the pneumococcal vaccine.
