REGIONAL TRAINING OF SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS (SPAs) AND CAMPUS JOURNALISTS (CJs)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. As Mandated in the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Regional Training of School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists shall be held on November 24-25, 2015 at the Applied Nutrition Center (ANC), Cebu City.
2. The training aims to develop the journalistic skills of new teacher advisers and the campus journalists.
3. The training aims to develop the journalistic skills of the SPAs and CJs on the following areas: 1) Editorial Writing; 2) Science and Technology Writing; 3) Copyreading and Headline Writing; and 4) Feature Writing.
4. Important topics such as Managing a School Publication and issues on Plagiarism will also be discussed.
5. Board and lodging of the participants, snacks, supplies and other incidental and miscellaneous needs relative to the training shall be charged against SARO No. OSEC-7-15-2541, September 22, 2015. Travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds/local school board funds/school journalism funds/PTA funds or other available resources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
