SUBJECT: AREA VII BASIC TRAINING COURSE FOR TROOP LEADERS

- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Cebu Council shall conduct a BASIC TRAINING COURSE FOR TROOP LEADERS on January 29-31, 2016 at Maya Elementary School, Daanbantayan, Cebu.
- 2. Participants in this training course are those who are newly hired teachers, teaching from Grade 4-6, who want to refresh their Scouting knowledge and skills, potential leaders of boys, manifest leadership skills and interest to learn the rudiments of Scouting.
- 3. The registration fee is Php 500.00 per attendee which will be used to defray training expenses such as supply and materials, certificates and other miscellaneous expenses related to the training.
- 4. Participants are required to wear the Scout Neckerchief with carabao slide. Furthermore, they should come in casual attire and comfortable shoes. Appropriate attire should be observed all the time. Registration will start at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 29, 2016 while the Opening Ceremonies will be held at 6:00 p.m. Closing ceremonies will be on Sunday, January 31, 2016 at 3:00 p.m.
- 5. Night sessions are conducted on Friday and Saturday. Participants are advised to stay within the venue until the whole duration of the training.
- 6. Things to bring: sleeping gears, toiletries, medicine (maintenance), clothing, notebook, ballpen, folder (long), cellophane tape (ex. Scotch Tape), 2 meters x1/4 diameter rope (for knot tying) and a pair of scissors.
