This is with regard to the status of the DepEd Computerization Program Batch 20/23B. The supplier that was awarded this contract has failed to complete the delivery of computer packages. The ground for termination is by default as "outside of force majeure, the Supplier failed to deliver or perform any or all of the Goods within the period(s) specified in the contract, or within any extension thereof granted by the Procuring Entity pursuant to a request made by the Supplier prior to the delay, and such failure has already exceeded ten percent (10%) of the contact price", as indicated in the implementing rules and regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act.

As such, the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS) will facilitate another procurement of computer packages for the schools where the supplier failed to deliver. While the ICTS still cannot provide the date as to when the schools will receive their computer packages, please know that this office is trying its best to be able to provide the computer packages at the soonest possible time.
