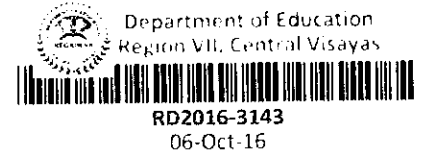

1. The Department of Education joins the AD/HD Society of the Philippines in celebrating the **2016 National Attention Deficit/Hyperactive Disorder (AD/HD) Awareness Week** with the theme *Turning Disability into This Ability* from October 16 to 22, 2016. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 472 dated September 18, 2003, which declared the third week of October of every year as *National Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (AD/HD) Awareness Week* in the country.

2. The week-long Celebration aims to:

- a. increase public awareness on the effects of the characteristics and social issues faced by people with AD/HD;
- b. promote understanding and acceptance of people with AD/HD; and
- c. campaign for equal rights and access to basic services, such as education, health and development which are often denied to persons with disability.

3. To support this occasion, all schools are encouraged to participate in this Celebration, together with the Special Education (SPED) Centers, and schools offering program for children with AD/HD in the forefront. Schools may conduct some of the activities listed below, provided that the engaged *Time-on-Task Policy* as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 shall be observed:

- a. Hanging of streamers;
- b. Launching of the week-long activity campaign through:
 - i. Arts Workshop for Children and Youth with AD/HD;
 - ii. Community and parents' forum on understanding and possible employment of people with AD/HD;
 - iii. Seminar on Drug Abuse Prevention; and
 - iv. Exhibit on educational services offered to children with AD/HD.

PROCLAMATION No. 472

DECLARING THE THIRD WEEK OF OCTOBER OF EVERY YEAR AS "NATIONAL ATTENTION
DEFICIT/HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER (AD/HD) AWARENESS WEEK"

WHEREAS, AD/HD is a common serious neuro-biological disorder in every country affecting some three (3%) percent to four (4%) percent of the country's population;

WHEREAS, AD/HD is a chronic brain disorder with social, academic and emotional impacts which can affect an estimated four (4) million Filipinos nationwide;

WHEREAS, lack of understanding and awareness about AD/HD leads to misconceptions and social stigma which hinder access to effective treatment, increases the risk of co-morbid conditions and complications such as conduct disorder, oppositional defiant disorder and anti-social disorder;

WHEREAS, the unmitigated condition of AD/HD may lead to the increased incidence of out-of-school youths and child abuse and neglect;

WHEREAS, several studies have shown that as high as seventy (70%) percent of juvenile offenders and forty (40%) percent of adult prisoners were found to have AD/HD;

WHEREAS, most persons with AD/HD have above-average intelligence, are highly creative, have deep stores of energy, have the ability to multi-tasking, and thus, have the potential to become path-beaters;

WHEREAS, the AD/HD individual, with proper management and support, can lead productive and fruitful lives and contribute to the nation's moral, financial and spiritual recovery.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the third week of October of every year as "National Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (AD/HD) Week" under the auspices of the AD/HD Society of the Philippines, Inc.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

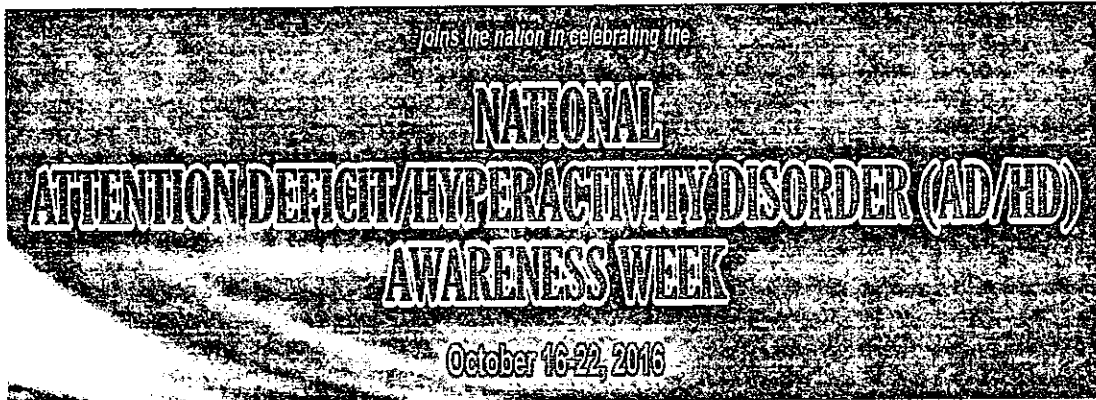
