GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR JUDGING THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS DURING THE AREA AND DIVISION LEVEL KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

A. FOLKDANCE CONTEST

- 1. Each group shall be composed of 12 members.
- 2. Each group shall be given 5 minutes to perform including entrance and exit.
- 3. The winner shall be chosen by the panel of judges based on the following criteria:

Performance > 25%
(this includes grace, timing, appropriate facial expression and execution)

Choreography > 25%

Costume > 20%

(this includes appropriateness of costumes with the folkdance)

General effectiveness > 20%

(this includes the overall appeal of the performance)

Audience Impact > 10%

TOTAL > 100%

B. STORY READING (MTB)

- 1. Contestants will be gathered in the assigned room.
- 2. Coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestants once the competitions start.
- 3. The contestants will be given 2 minutes to acquaint himself/herself with the piece/story.
- 4. The contestants will be given 3 minutes to read the story which shall be given only during the contest proper.
- 5. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

C. Picture Story Telling

- 1. Contestants will be gathered in the assigned room.
- 2. Coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestants once the competitions start.
- 3. The contestants shall be given 2 minutes to study the picture and frame a story about it.
- 4. Each contestant will be given 3 minutes to tell a story about the picture.
- 5. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

Relevance to the Picture		>	15%
Organization of Ideas/Creativity		>	35%
Voice Projection		>	20%
Clarity of Expression		>	20%
Audience Appeal/Impact		>	10%

D. Drawing

- 1. Each contestant will draw on a piece of a long bond paper using crayons and pencil.
- 2. The bond paper should have a prepared 1 inch-margin on all sides using black pentel pen.
- 3. Contestants should bring their own materials for the contest.
- 4. The drawing should depict the theme- Ang Akong Komunidad
- 5. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme		>	25%
Creativity		>	25%
Color Harmony		>	25%
Neatness		>	25%

E. Vocal Solo Competition

- 1. Contestant is free to choose any MTB song.
- 2. Performance time is 2 to 3 minutes including entrance and exit.
- 3. Contestant may use any form of accompaniment-minus one, guitar, etc., however the contestant is allowed to sing without accompaniment.
- 4. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

Voice Quality		>	25%
Projection and Showmanship		>	25%
Diction		>	15%
Dynamics		>	10%
Mastery		>	15%
Audience Impact		>	10%

F. Creative Dance Competition

- 1. Each group is composed of 3 pairs or a total of 6 members.
- Each group will create dance steps depicting a certain sport of their choice.
 (ex. If they choose basketball, their steps shall include dribbling, shooting, throwing, etc)
- 3. Time of performance shall not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.
- 4. Props should be naturally placed on stage during the performance.
- 5. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

Choreography		>	20%	
Grace and footwork			>	25%
Mastery and coordination		>	20%	
Attire/Costume		>	10%

G. Nursery Rhyme Recitation (English)

- 1. Each contestant will recite a nursery rhyme of his/her choice.
- 2. Each contestant will be given 1 to 2 minutes to recite including entrance and exit.
- 3. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

Diction		>	20%	
Expression and showmanship		>	25%	
Mastery		>	20%	
Costume		>	5%	
Audience Impact		>	5%

H. Duet (MTB)

- 1. Contestants are free to choose any MTB song.
- 2. Performance time is 2 to 3 minutes including entrance and exit.
- 3. Contestants may use any form of accompaniment-minus one, guitar, etc., however the contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.
- 4. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:

Rhythm	>	15%
Dynamics	>	15%
Diction	>	15%
Mastery and Showmanship	>	20%
Audience Impact	>	10%
