- Why is this topic important to the field?
- What is the conceptual orientation for the presentation?

#### (B) Usefulness to Educators (15 points)

- How does the information presented in the session translate to improved instructional practice?
- What practices are being targeted and how can recommendations improve student performance?

## (C) Relevance to Learners, Families, and/or Educators (10 points)

- How does this proposal improve the knowledge and educational outcomes of students with disabilities?
- How does this proposal benefit marginalized groups specially students with disabilities?

#### (C) Participant Outcomes (10 points)

- Provide 2 to 3 participant outcomes that are appropriate for the intended audience and focus of your proposal.
