



Release of funds amounting to Six Million One Hundred Ninety-One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Four Pesos (Php 6,191,884:00) to defray expenses for transportation, meals, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses during the conduct of activities which shall be charged against 2015 BALS Continuing funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
- 4. Authority for Ms. ERLINDA G.
