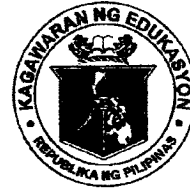



Subject: Conduct of Survey for Identified CO-led Programs in Randomly Selected Schools

In 2016, the School Effectiveness Division-Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development (SED-BHROD) with the Planning Service and Bureau of Learning Delivery developed a monitoring tool using the Android mobile application CSPro. This technology provides ease in the encoding and analysis of the gathered information, thus will be faster to process for data analysis. The purpose of this monitoring activity is to gather data on the implementation of different programs as input to program adjustment.

This monitoring tool was initially used in the data gathering for the five (5) Learning Equity and Accountability Program Support (LEAPS) Regions: Regions CAR, V, VIII, IX and Caraga. It covered the following DepEd areas of concern:

1. Early Language Literacy and Numeracy
2. Results-based Performance Management System
3. Enhanced School Improvement Plan and School Report Card
4. School-based Management
5. School-to-School Partnership
6. Disadvantaged Learners

As part of our efforts to collect data representative of all schools nationwide, we will be conducting the same survey in the remaining 13 regions: Regions I, II, III, IVA, IVB, NCR, NIR, VI, VII, X, XI, XII, ARMM. It will cover the abovementioned six (6) areas, but will also include the following:

1. External Partnerships
2. Disaster Risk Reduction
3. Child Protection

The data collected from this monitoring survey will provide information relative to how the schools are implementing the aforementioned programs and policies, the areas needing support and assistance, as well as the best implementation practices. These will form part of a report which will provide basis on the review of all policies and guidelines pertaining to these programs' implementation, as well as the programming of assistance to the schools especially at the Division level.

In this regard, teams from the DepEd Central Office will conduct monitoring surveys to 400 randomly selected schools, with varying numbers per region from March to April 2017. As part of their monitoring and technical assistance functions, SBM Coordinators from the Regions (RO) and concerned Schools Division Offices (SDO) will also be requested to join the school visits.

Assistance is further requested from the Region for the facilitation of the rental of van and arrangement of meals for the team (CO, RO, SDO team members as well as School participants) during school visits. Funds for this purpose will be downloaded to the Regional Offices. Furthermore, list of schools will be provided per region prior to the actual conduct of the visits for the itinerary arrangements. Since schools were randomly selected, not all SDOs may be covered by this monitoring.
