

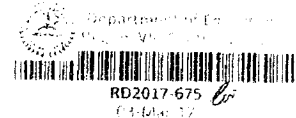

The Honor Awards Program (HAP) is the annual undertaking of the Civil Service Commission that recognizes civil servants who have given pride and glory to the government service, those who have displayed outstanding work performance.

As in the previous years, three (3) award categories are at stake, namely: Presidential or Lingkod Bayan Award, the Outstanding Public Officials and Employees or the Dangal ng Bayan Award and the Civil Service Commission Pagasa Award.

The Presidential or Lingkod Bayan Awardees, individual and group, shall receive a gold-gilded medallion and a plaque containing citation and signature of the President of the Philippines, PHP 200,000.00 cash reward, among others. The Outstanding Public Officials and Employees or the Dangal ng Bayan Awardees shall receive a trophy designed and executed by National Artist Sculpture Napoleon V. Abueva, and PHP 200,000.00 cash award among others. While for the third award, CSC Pagasa Award, awardees shall receive a gold-gilded medallion, a plaque signed by the Chairperson of the Civil Service Commission and PHP 100,000.00 cash award. For the past four (4) years, officials and employees from Region VII made it to the national level and we are proud of that accomplishment.

We believe that there are officials and employees in your agency who are worthy of the recognition. Thus, we encourage your Office to send nominations of public service exemplars under your jurisdiction and to promote the 2017 Search for Outstanding Government Workers.
