Warm greetings from Basa Pilipinas!

On April 19, 2017, Basa Pilipinas will launch its official Facebook Group, "Nagbabasa Kami!" This Facebook Group will provide post-training support to Basa Pilipinas-trained Kinder and Grades 1 to 3 teachers. This activity is part of Basa Pilipinas's approved work plan, and is being implemented with the cooperation of Department of Education's Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD).

"Nagbabasa Kami!" is a closed Facebook Group. Membership to the group will be done by e-mail invitation, which the Basa team will conduct in three batches:

**Batch 1** – Grades 2 and 3 teachers (to be invited a week before the launch)

**Batch 2** – Grade 1 teachers (to be invited after the Grade 1 RELI Training)

**Batch 3** – Kindergarten teachers (to be invited in July 2017)

To ensure wide reach and participation among the target teachers, **we would like to request your good office to help us disseminate information about the Facebook group to all Basa Pilipinas-trained teachers in your division.** We would appreciate your help in alerting the K-3 teachers about the upcoming Facebook Group launch, and that they should expect an email invitation from Basa Pilipinas as per the timeline indicated above.

By becoming members of the Nagbabasa Kami! Facebook Group, teachers will be able to access supplementary technical content about early grades reading instruction. Through this Facebook Group, they can also share insights about their own practices, seek clarifications about K-3 literacy instruction, and collectively learn from their shared experiences.

For teachers who do not have Facebook accounts, they will be encouraged to create one. During training and other Basa Pilipinas events (i.e. Distribution of Teaching and Learning Materials, National Reading Month), Basa Pilipinas will set up Facebook stations where interested teachers will be assisted in voluntarily creating their Facebook accounts.

Basa Pilipinas will lead in the development of content and management of the Facebook Group as administrators. We will work closely with the DepEd Bureau of Learning Delivery to periodically review the content to be posted on the Facebook Group. DepEd focal persons in Basa Pilipinas-supported divisions will also be given access to the Facebook Group as moderators.

We thank you in advance for your help in letting K-3 teachers know about this Facebook-based post-training support venue. With your endorsement and continued support, we hope to further assist our teachers by reinforcing effective literacy instruction in the classroom.
