Essay Writing

The essays will be judged according to the following criteria: Originality (20%), Content (30%), Proper Use of Words (30%), and Communication to Readers (20%). Participants of the Engineering Challenge By Schools may also participate in this contest. However, the participants of the Poster Making Contest and Science Race cannot join the Essay Writing Contest. Details of Activities



Opening Ceremonies

This activity shall be the formal opening of the Regional Science Camp. It shall be started with a prayer or doxology, national anthem, welcoming remarks, general orientation, and introduction of facilitators. Participants will be grouped into subcamps at the beginning of the event. These will be their primary groupings especially for Day 1.

Talk with Expert

An expert will give a talk about engineering, importance of innovations and inventions, and/or intellectual rights. He or she will guide the participants for the Workshop.

Workshop

The subcamps shall focus on a particular field of engineering. Each subcamp will be provided with materials and methodologies for its own unique product for the Workshop.

Eng'gage

Prior to the event, participants may opt to register in order for them to perform during the Eng'gage program, an entertainment program. Other performers may also perform. There shall also be a socials activity thereafter.

Engineering Challenge

There will be two kinds of Engineering Challenge: Engineering Challenge By Schools and Engineering Challenge By Subcamps.

For the Engineering Challenge By Schools, the methods and guidelines of a specific engineering project shall already be given before the start of the event. Please constantly visit the PSYSC Regional Council VII page in Facebook (www.facebook.com/psysrcvii) for updates and for the specific guidelines. The schools shall then present their respective projects on January 24, 2017 (Day 1). **Only one team composed of three (3) Grade 5 or Grade 6 students per school only.**

For the Engineering Challenge By Subcamps, the methods and guidelines of a specific engineering project shall be given after the Workshop in Day 1. The subcamps will then present their fabricated projects during the Invention and Innovation Expo on Day 2.

Invention and Innovation Expo

Each subcamp will present its product from the Workshop for the Engineering Challenge By Subcamps in a one-hour invention and innovation expo. Participants may also present their own projects from their schools in this activity. The best subcamp project and the best innovative project shall be awarded.

Hataw

Before the start of the events for Day 2, there shall be a dance or Zumba session in order to prepare the participants for the coming challenging physical activities.

Science Race

Simultaneous with the Poster Making and the Essay Writing, the Science Race shall take place. The competing teams will be the different participating schools. **A team from one school shall be composed of five (5) Grade 5 or Grade 6 students.** The science race will have stations with specific tests or activities. Participants of the Engineering Challenge By Schools may also participate in this contest. However, the participants of the Poster Making Contest and Essay Writing Contest cannot join the Science Race. Please constantly visit the PSYSC Regional Council VII page in Facebook (www.facebook.com/psysrcvii) for updates and for the specific guidelines.

Poster Making

Simultaneous with the Science Race and the Essay Writing Contest, the Poster Making Contest shall take place. **Only one (1) representative per school shall be allowed to join in this contest. The theme for the Poster Making Contest will be announced on the spot.** Posters must be original. Each participants must bring a ¼ illustration board together with his or her own art materials.
