**2017 TEACHING-LEARNING SUMMER INSTITUTE (TELSI 2017) FOR TEACHER-LEADERS (GRADES 7-9/3<sup>RD</sup> BATCH)**

1. This Office announces the conduct of the **four-day 2017 Teaching-Learning Summer Institute (TELSI 2017-3<sup>rd</sup>/Last Batch)** with the theme: **“Strengthening ‘Eng-Sci-Math’ Teaching-Learning Toward Excellence in K-12 Basic Education”** on **June 1-4, 2017 (Thursday-Sunday)** at DepEd Ecotech Center with the partner hotel/service provider, **Hotel Fortuna in Magallanes St., Cebu City**. The training starts on a **Thursday (June 1<sup>st</sup>)** and ends on a **Sunday (June 4<sup>th</sup>)**. Registration is at **6:00AM-7:30AM** on Thursday/June 1st. The **Opening Program** will start at around **8:00AM**. **Participants from the municipalities of Bantayan (7 pax), Pilar (9 pax), Tudela (3 pax) and Sta. Fe (3 pax)** are given **Day 0 (Zero)**. **Check-in time** is at around **5:00PM** on **May 31<sup>st</sup>/Wednesday**. **However, the first meal/snack will be served at 9:00AM on Day One (1)/Thursday**. This means that participants who are given **Day 0 (Zero)** will shoulder the cost/s of their dinner (**Day 0**) and breakfast on **Day 1 (One)** as their personal contribution/counterpart for this training.

2. Participants are **grade level leaders** from the **selected secondary/integrated schools** for **Grades 7-9** with specializations in **English, Science and Math (104 pax for the last batch)**. For the **third/last batch**, please see the attached participating schools and the names of the participants.

3. Public Schools District Supervisors were directed to submit the names of the consolidated participants from the secondary/integrated schools within the district/s as stipulated in **Div. Memo No. 229 s., 2017** but as of this date, there were still **PSDSs who failed** to send via email the needed data, in this regard **PSDSs/School Heads concerned** were directed to submit the needed data **immediately** so that those teachers who were not included in the official attached listing can still **attend or participate**. For the **third/last batch**, the training management can only accommodate around **50 additional**

participants. Please send the names/listing via email at [v\\_ybanez@yahoo.com](mailto:v_ybanez@yahoo.com) by the close of business (COB) on 25 May 2017 (Thursday) in Excel format.

4. The training is on **live-in/stay-in** arrangement. Participants are also directed to bring the necessary stuffs/materials that are needed for this training such as **curriculum guides**, sample **daily lessons plans/lesson logs in their respective fields of specializations**, books (English, Science, Math), prescription medicines, etc. Schools heads concerned are advised to follow strictly the intent and purposes of this training as regards to the criteria on the qualified participants to attend.

5. The **Learning & Development (L&D) Section** is seeking **patience and understanding** to all participants, speakers and support staffs for having training/s during Saturdays, Sundays or even holidays. This is noted that for future training plans as much as possible this will no longer be repeated but for this Summer 2017, the **L & D Section is managing multiple trainings** in which due to **logistical and scheduling concerns**, conducting trainings during Saturdays or Sundays cannot be avoided.


6. Members of the training team, trainers, admin/logistics support staffs will be given **Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)** for the services rendered during **Saturday or Sunday**. However, if any of those personnel mentioned are not entitled to avail for a CTO, they (including the **participants**) will be given **leave or service credits or overtime pay (as the case maybe)** in accordance to existing Civil Service Commission (CSC) or DepEd Orders/Issuances. **Teacher-participants are given service credits for the four-day participation of this INSTITUTE.**

7. This **Memorandum** serves as **Travel Authority** of the **participants**, trainers, admin/logistics/technical training support staffs as well as the other members of the training team/management.

8. Travelling expenses of the **participants** shall be charged to the **schools' MOOE** while travelling expenses of the **trainers/speakers/EPSS'** shall be charged to the **Division's MOOE**. **Expenses for the food or meals/snacks, lodging accommodations, materials given to the participants/trainers and other related/incidental costs for this training shall be charged to the Division's HRTD Funds**, subject to its availability and the usual accounting/auditing rules and regulations.

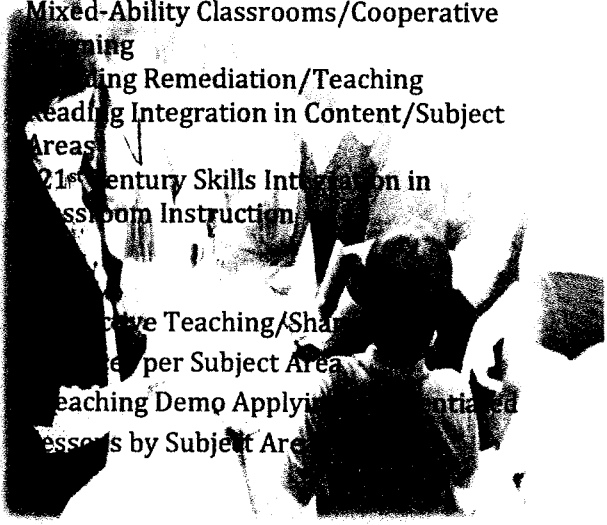

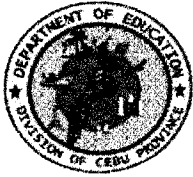


