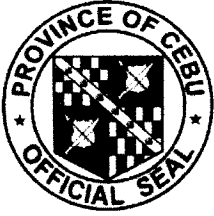
**INVITATION FOR THE 2017 BATANG PINOY

The Cebu Provincial Sports Commission is organizing the Cebu Provincial Youth Games, a multi- event sports competition for students and out of school youth who are 15 years old and younger or those who are born March 1, 2002 and thereafter. This is part of our grassroots sports development program which we have instituted in partnership with the Department of Education.

As an initial activity, the project will likewise serve as a preliminary selection process to choose potential athletes who will represent Cebu Province to the Batang Pinoy and CVIRAA Meet. There will be fourteen events to be contested during the Cebu Provincial Youth Games which will be held in various dates and venues:


