There is **no registration fee**, however, each participant will be charged for their lunch at an amount of **Php. 157.50**

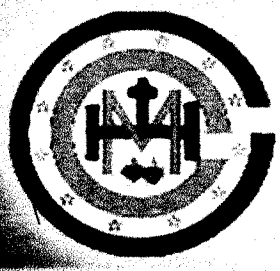
