

School students age between 8 to 11 years old.

A school team is composed of two (2) students and one (1) accompanying science teacher.

Water Rocket Competition Rules:

1. Each school team should make two (2) rockets. Each student will receive:
 - Six (6) 1.5 Liter PET Bottles
 - PVC Sheets (217 x 331 mm, 200 mic)
 - Three (3) pcs. Marking Tape (6m each)
 - Scissors
 - Pen Knife
 - Ruler
 - Plasticine (Clay)
2. The students are encouraged to be creative in the design of the nose cones and fins of their water rocket.
3. The launch aims at precision flight of the rocket. A target will be placed with the center 80 m. from the launcher
4. The distance will be measured from the center of the target to the point of impact. The rocket that lands closest to the bull's eye gets the best score.
5. During the competition, each school team will be given opportunities to conduct two (2) launches. Exact distance from the point of impact and the center of target will be measured. The result of the best launch will be recorded.
6. Each school team will be given a voucher to conduct one (1) test launch prior to the competition.
7. In order to reduce possibility of error, the students will draw lots of their launching sequence and assigned with the respective launchers. In this way, the students can practice with the assigned launcher during the trial.
8. Students may adjust the volume of water, air pressure, launch angle and direction at the time of launch. There is no limit on water volume but air pressure must not exceed 80 psi (5.516 bar).
9. The school team that achieves the best score, i.e. the best score of the two (2) launches as stated in item 5 will be declared as the winner of the competition.
10. In case of a draw, the two launches will be taken into consideration to determine the winner between the competitors.

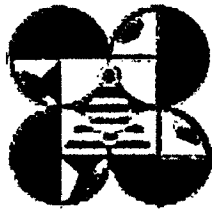
Poster Contest Rules:

Theme: "UNITY THROUGH SPACE"

This Poster Contest encourages children to explore their creativity, expand their imaginations and express friendship by means of cooperating with all groups regardless of border in the point of view of space.

Drawing / Painting Rules:

- Drawing / painting must be made on paper of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) at minimum and A2 size (420 x 594 mm) at maximum. DOST-SEI will provide A3 size paper.
- Acceptable Tools of drawing / painting include pencil, crayon, water color, oil painting, computer drawing, etc. However, photos, wires, and other 3D objects are not accepted. The completed artwork must be a flat piece of paper.
- The drawing / painting must **NOT** include slogans. The drawing / painting must **NOT** represent any particular individual, organization, country or brand name and must not depict any religious theme. Any artwork that violates any of these restrictions is subject to be disqualified from the voting process for the poster awards.
- Each drawing / painting must have the name of the participant(s) and his / her / their country in English on the back side.
