
As Henry David Thoreau said, "There is one consolation in being sick; and that is the possibility that you may recover to a better state than you were ever in before."

I am Charisse S. Sinangote, 29 years old, a mother to a 6-year old daughter. I've been in the service of DepEd Cebu Province for 5 years already. Last year, I was diagnosed with brain tumor on my brain stem and had undergone VP shunt operation to drain the excess fluid in my head, favorably it was successful. After the operation I opt for an alternative medicine to treat the tumor as I have my reservation to undergo the operation for tumor extraction with limited funds. In August 2017, I was admitted twice at UCMed Hospital and in ICU for a bilateral pneumonia and had a Tracheostomy Tube Insertion to alleviate my condition. For my brain tumor, the doctor has advised for a 32 – days radiation therapy which cost about 2,500 pesos per day. Despite all of these, we are hopeful for a positive result and thus, we need to comply all the necessary medication to restore me back to health. However, we have used up all our savings, donations, and even have sold property for my medications.


