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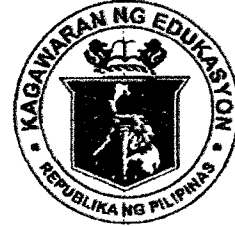

CLIMATE CHANGE CONSCIOUSNESS WEEK

1. The Department of Education (DepED) Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) in coordination with DepED Region VII will spearhead the conduct of the Regional Caravan Activities scheduled to run simultaneously on November 6-17, 2017. The activities will raise awareness on the science and impact of climate change and ramp-up preparations for the National Conference on Climate Change on November 20-21, 2017. The Caravan will educate school administrators, teachers, learners and stakeholders on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) and Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (CCAM).

2. A Regional Conference for DepED Region VII will be on November 17, 2017 at DepEd Ecotech Center, Sudlon, Lahug, Cebu City. Participants to this said activity shall be four representatives from each Schools Divisions composed of School Head, Teacher, Student and DRRM Coordinator (or alternate)

3. Travel, per diem and other incidental expenses of participants will be charged from sourced funds/sponsors and or division/school local MOOE funds while breakfast, lunch and 2 snacks as well as board and lodging of national speakers will be shouldered by Regional Office care of the DRRMS downloaded funds subject to proper accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Schools are also encouraged to conduct school-level activities related to climate change (quiz bee, photo/video documentation, tree planting, others) adaptation and mitigation any day from November 6-17, 2017. They are requested further to post online their photos, videos, and other media of the activities and to use the official DRRM hashtag #ResilienceEducationPH in social media sites (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter).
