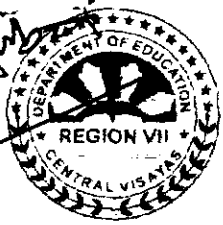

Greetings from the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT)!

It is the DICT's mandate to ensure the rights of individuals to privacy and confidentiality of their personal information; ensure the security of critical ICT infrastructure including information assets of the government, individuals, and businesses; and provide oversight over agencies governing and regulating the ICT sector and ensure consumer protection and welfare, data privacy and security, foster competition, and the growth of the ICT sector.

To fulfill this mandate, National Cybersecurity Plan (NCSP) 2022 was launched last December 9, 2016 and followed by a Roundtable Discussion with different NGA's, Academe and Private Sectors last January 23, 2017.
