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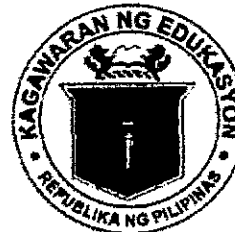

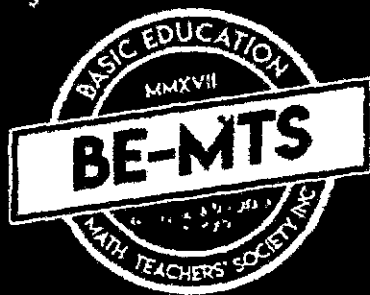

"A Math Quiz Bowl Using Calculator"

Rationale

Calcu-lympics will improve critical-thinking and problem solving skills of the students with the use of technology. This will also open collaboration with participating public and private schools for the research projects prepared by BE-MTS for our region this academic year 2018-2019.

What is Calcu-lympics?

With the current technological-innovations of calculators nowadays, it can now facilitate critical-thinking and problem solving skills of the students. These calculators have already recent features that will allow students to arrive at the final answer in a shorter period of time. These features will help the students finish their **Performance Task** at a desirable time frame.

Calcu-lympics is a kind of quiz bowl where students will be tested on their knowledge on mathematical concepts. They will also be challenged to solve real-life problems using a calculator. This kind of quiz bowl is just similar to a traditional quiz bowl where many students are used to join. The difference is that, in this kind of quiz bowl, all items will require the students to use calculator to display their knowledge on mathematical concepts and test their ability to solve real-life problems.

Venue

March 24, 2018 (Saturday)
Buttenbruch Hall, University of San Carlos, Cebu City
(venue may change, the participating schools will just be notified)

Prizes

1st place - ₱5,000 and trophy
2nd place - ₱3,500 and trophy
3rd place - ₱2,000 and trophy
Consolation Prizes for the non-winning finalists

Mechanics

The participating schools may send at most three (3) pairs of students. They shall bring with them the calculator fx991EX model of CASIO during the competition. Each pair of participants will undergo the easy and moderate rounds. Their scores in these rounds will be accumulated. The top ten (10) pairs will be considered as finalist and can proceed to the final round. In the final round, their scores will be back to zero. After the final round, the pairs with the top three (3) highest scores will be declared as the winners. The non-winning finalists will receive consolation prizes

Registration Fee

Each pair of participating students will pay ₱900. However, if their coach is a member of BE-MTS (Basic Education - Math Teachers' Society Inc.), they shall be paying only an amount of ₱800 each pair. The registration fee is inclusive of certificate of participation, quiz bowl writing materials and t-shirts for the students and the coach.
