AREA V BASIC TRAINING COURSE FOR KAWAN AND TROOP LEADERS

1. The Cebu Council BSP shall conduct a **BASIC TRAINING COURSE FOR KAWAN LEADERS AND OUTFIT ADVISORS** on April 13 – April 15, 2018 at Aloguinsan Central School, Aloguinsan, Cebu.
