## MONTHLY VEGETABLE AND TREE GROWING ACTIVITY

1. In support to the government's effort to mitigate climate change and promote food security in schools, this Office informs the field of the **Vegetable and Tree Growing Activity** which shall be held on the following dates for school year 2018-2019:

- 2. The school sites are the priority planting areas, but the sites stipulated in the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by the DA, DENR, RAFI and LGUs shall also be used.
- 3. The participants to this activity are Grades 5-12 learners in all public elementary and secondary schools, teachers, including ALS mobile teachers, and non-teaching personnel in the districts and division office, with one seedling per month, a total of 10 grown trees per participant

by April 2019. It is emphasized that a parental consent shall be secured by each learner before joining the activity.

- 4. Endemic fruit/forest tree seedlings shall be prepared and taken cared of in all school nurseries. In addition, planting information drive shall be conducted by the Focal persons, EPP/TLE teachers to all who are involved in the said activity.
- 5. Monitoring of growing seedling trees shall be done by elementary and secondary school learners, teachers, DepEd personnel, Our Cebu Sustainable Project/Greening Philippines Planting coordinators, school administrators, PTA and other stakeholders who are involved in the National Greening Program (NGP).
- 6. Submission of district consolidated report using Form A & B (in hard copies) is expected two weeks after Vegetable and Tree Growing Day. (Attn: Dr. Eva A. Casinillo or Mary Candice Tibor at SGOD Office)
- 7. Consolidated yearly report on Vegetable and Tree Growing Activity (to be submitted on April 12, 2019) shall form part of the requirements for graduation of both Grade VI and Grade 12 students. The said report together with ten (10) geo-tagged pictures shall also be the required documents for promotion of teachers, school heads and district supervisors. There shall be a regular inspection and validation of data on the number of growing trees by the District/Division/Region/Greening/PENRO/NGP Focal Persons.
- 6. This office shall grant Service Credits to teachers and CTO to school heads, district supervisors, division supervisors/coordinators/personnel who are involved in this activity.
