Event: REGIONAL JUNIOR, SENIOR AND CADET CAMP

Date & Venue: October 24-28, 2018
MYVRPTC "Camp Marina", Barangay Kalunasan, Cebu City

Theme: "Girl Scouts: Explore*Endure*Excel"

Participants: District/Division Delegation, these will be:
Junior - minimum of four (4) patrols of eight (8) girls with two (2) Adult Leaders per patrol
Senior - minimum of four (4) patrol of eight (8) girls with one (1) Adult Leader per Council

Camp Fee: P4, 000.00 per camper
To cover food, accommodation, program materials, souvenirs with t-shirt and tours

First meal is breakfast of October 24 and last meal is lunch of October 28.

Arrival and Settling Down: October 24, 2018 morning
Opening Program : October 24, 2018 at 4:00 pm
Closing Program : October 28, 2018 at 9:00 am
Departure : October 28, 2018 afternoon

Qualifications of Participants:

Girls: - must be registered Junior, Senior & Cadet Girl Scouts as of November 30, 2018
- must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician
- must have earned at least one badge under the challenge of Environment, Preparedness, Arts, Heritage and Citizenship

Adult: - must be registered Troop Leader as of November 30, 2018
- must have undertaken the Outdoor Leadership Course or must be a Campcraft Certificate Holder
- must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
- must know and understand her girls
- must know simple First Aid

*** A Physical re-check shall be conducted upon arrival in camp. Be sure that the Girls shall be bringing with them their individual Health Form and Parent's Consent form during the physical re-check in camp.**

The activities shall include:

- Junior:** Handicraft, Martial Arts, Adventure Games, Session on Free Being Me/ABC, Session on Spirituality and Well Being, Session on Drug Awareness, Emergency Preparedness, Council Extravaganza, Campfire, Scout's Own and Tour.
- Senior:** Obstacle games, Session on Drug Awareness, Handicraft, Sessions on Free Being Me/ABC, Session on Spirituality and Well Being, Ham Radio, Rappelling, Martial Arts, Council Extravaganza, Campfire, Scout's Own and Tour.


