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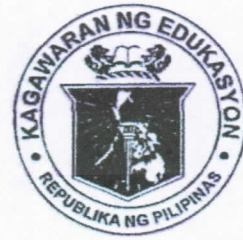



The program aims to provide financial assistance to public elementary and secondary Mathematics and Science teachers who are already pursuing/will pursue post graduate studies in the said fields. The applicant must be a resident of NGCP host communities/barangays identified in the attached list (Annex A).

The scholarship will cover the following expenses:

- a. tuition and miscellaneous fees not exceeding P15,000.00 per semester
- b. book allowance of P5,000.00 per semester
- c. monthly stipend (5 months) of P5,000.00 per semester
- d. one-time dissertation/thesis allowance of P30,000.00
