Japanese Speakers' Forum Philippines 2019 (JSFP 2019) Call for Application

1. Overview:

The Japan Foundation and the Kamenori Foundation are co-presenting the Japanese Speakers' Forum (JS Forum), in order to create a model of Japanese language education, to develop a network of Japanese Speakers in secondary education and to promote mutual understanding among youths in Asia. The JS Forum provides both learners and teachers a platform to interact and share with each other experiences in studying the Japanese-language and to further enhance 21st century skills – ability to learn and grow independently, ability to think independently, and achieve collaborative presentation skills.

In echoing with the objectives of the JS Forum, the Japanese Speakers' Forum Philippines 2019 provides the opportunity for students and teachers in the Philippines to interact and discuss local as well as global issues and to communicate using their common languages - Filipino, English and Japanese. With this year's theme focusing on spreading information about "ECO (Environment and Economy)". The participating students are to reflect on eco-activity, and to ponder (to seriously consider) the garbage problems. The final output will be the promotion of ECO to all other NIHONGO-JINS.

The Filipino students will be joined by 10 Japanese high school students who will be visiting the Philippines during the time of the forum.

In line with the program, Philippine representatives will be selected among the participants to participate in the Japanese Speakers' Forum 2019 International Forum.

2. Date: January 23 - 25, 2019

*Participating students and teachers are required to stay in the provided accommodation all throughout the forum and to participate in all the activities.

3. Venue: Robinsdale Residences (tentative)

4. Invited participants:

Open to ONLY 30 Grade 9 high school students (1 male and 1 female from each school) & ONLY 15 high school teachers from 15 SPFL: Japanese Implementers

*If applicants exceed 30 students and 15 teachers, screening will be held.

*Grade 9 students are priority, however if there would be less than 30 Grade 9 students, JFM shall consider accepting students from other grades (Grade 7/8/10; 1 student from each school) to fill in the 30 slots.

*Grade 9 students are priority, but Grade 7, 8, 10 students may still apply, however they are not eligible to be chosen for the Japanese Speakers' Forum 2019 international forum.

5. Deadline of Application forms and Essay: 11 November, 2018 (Sunday)

*To be submitted through e-mail ONLY: jsforumphil@gmail.com

*Due to limited slots, application rules shall be strictly implemented. ONLY on-time and fully-accomplished application forms and essay shall be accepted on or before 11 November 2018.

6. Eligibility and Qualification of participants (students)

Eligible and qualified to apply for this program are those who:

- a. hold nationality or permanent residency in the Philippines;
- are currently Grade 9 students (priority) and studying Japanese language at a school implementing "SPFL: Nihongo" as of January 23, 2019;
- c. are non-native speakers of Japanese;
- d. have never stayed in Japan for over 10 months continuously in the past 5 years as of August 2019;
- e. have never been to Japan through any of the programs by the Japan Foundation and/or any other agency of the Japanese government (e.g. JENESYS);
- f. are in good physical and mental health; and
- g. have the consent of a parent/guardian.
- h. meet the following qualifications:
 - 1. A student who is very eager to learn Nihongo.
- A student who actively participates in both Japanese-language classes and related activities such as club activities in school.
- 3. A student who is willing to explore and experience different cultures.
- 4. A student who is good at working collaboratively.
- 5. A student who is open to the views and opinions of others.
- 6. A student who exerts efforts to express one's thoughts and opinions
- 7. A student who is willing and is capable to share the experience and knowledge gained during the Japanese Speakers' Forum 2018 in Japan to his/her schoolmates, teachers, friends and the community in general if he/she is selected as a representative of the Philippines.
- *For schools with Grade 9 students (as of January 23, 2019): Maximum of 2 students (1 male and 1 female)
- *For schools with only Grade 7/Grade 8/Grade 10 students: Only 1 student (NOTE: Due to the rules set by the international forum, this student shall not be eligible to be a candidate for the Japanese Speakers' Forum Philippines 2019 Selection, however he/she is encouraged to join because first and foremost this program's goal is to provide a meaningful venue for interaction and learning among students and teachers.)
- *Students chosen for the JSFP 2019 should be different from students to be chosen for 11th Nihongo Quiz Bee for High School Students (2019).
