1. In preparation for the smooth conduct of the 2018 Dance Sport Competition, this Office hereby issues the guidelines to be adhered to by all the coaches from Municipalities with entries in said event.
2. PSDSs, School Heads and coaches are enjoined to follow strictly the guidelines.
3. In line with said preparation, all Dance Sport Coaches from the identified Municipalities with entries are directed to attend the One-Day Conference on November 29, 2018 at 9:00 in the morning at the CID Office.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. COMPETING COUPLES:

- a. The competition is open to couples who won the Municipal Meet of Dancesport Competition.
- b. If no lower competition meet was held in the Municipal level, the only allowed couples to compete in the Cebu Provincial Sports Meet Dancesports Competition 2018 are those that are endorsed by their respective MAPEH Coordinators.
- c. Couples that are found in the official gallery forwarded by DSAC will be allowed to compete.

2. TEAM COMPOSITION:

- a. Each division will be represented with a total of eight (8) competing couples:
 - i. **Juvenile Level / Elementary with age bracket of (6 – 13 yrs. old)**
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade C category (Latin American)
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade C category (Modern Standard)
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade E category (Latin American)
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade E category (Modern Standard)
 - ii. **Junior Level / High School with age bracket of (14 – 18 yrs. old)**
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade C category (Latin American)
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade C category (Modern Standard)
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade E category (Latin American)
 - One (1) couple will compete in grade E category (Modern Standard)

3. EVENTS OF THE COMPETITION

- a. Each couple will compete on the following discipline (Modern Standard and Latin American) and several events. No dances other than the ones listed will be performed.
- b. Change of partners is **STRICTLY NOT** allowed.
- c. A competitor must only perform one discipline either Latin American or Modern Standard. For example, if the competitor already competes in Latin – American, s/he is not allowed to compete in the other discipline which is Modern Standard.
- d. There will be separate winners from each event.

4. COSTUME / DRESS REGULATIONS

- a. The dress and costumes of the competitor shall follow the international standard dress code or the ones prescribed by the National Sports Association (NSA) or the Dancesports Council of the Philippines (DSCPI).
- b. Failure to follow correct dress code or costume of each level will be disqualified.
- c. No change of dress or additional use of accessories or colors is permitted during any round of a competition.
- d. See attachment for more detailed information with regards to proper dress code and costume.

5. MUSIC

- a. There will only be one (1) official music for each dance and it will have a time limit of 1 minute and 30 seconds.
- b. The tempo of each dances shall be:

- Waltz	28-30 beats / min	- Chachacha	30-32 beats / min
- Tango	31-33 beats / min	- Samba	50-52 beats / min
- Quickstep	50-52 beats / min	- Rumba	25-27 beats / min
		- Jive	42-44 beats / min

1. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

- a. The competitors will be adjudicated according to the following set of criteria:
 - i. Technical Qualities
 - ii. Movement to music
 - iii. Partnering Skills
 - iv. Showmanship and Presentation

2. AWARDING OF WINNERS

1st Place – Gold Medal and a Certificate

2nd Place – Silver Medal and a Certificate

3rd Place – Bronze Medal and a Certificate

All participants and Coaches will receive Certificates of Recognition and Participation.

3. OTHERS:

- a. Participation in the event is entirely at the dancers' own risk.
- b. Performance of dangerous routines and highlights is not endorsed by the competition committee (and will not be reflected favorably in the scoring).
- c. Lifts are **NOT PERMITTED** in any discipline. A lift is any movement during which one members of a couple has both feet off the floor at the same time with the assistance of the other partner
- d. Identification (ID) must be word inside the venue at all times.
- e. Competitors must be present at the venue before the start of the event. Late comers may be disqualified.
- f. Decision of the board of the adjudicators is final and irrevocable.
- g. Schedule of blockings will be announced during the Coaches' meeting.

2. No decoration in clothing, body or hair.

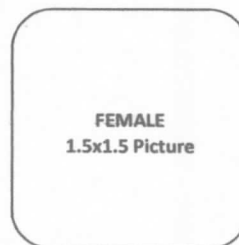
