- must have attended troop and district camps

**Adults** - must be a registered Troop Leader, Co-Leader, BC whose membership is not expiring on November 2018

- must have undertaken a Basic Course and Outdoor Leadership
- must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
- must know and understand her girls
- must know the basics and attended a training in First Aid

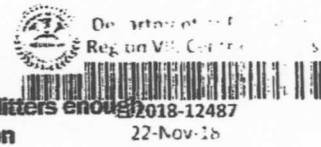




