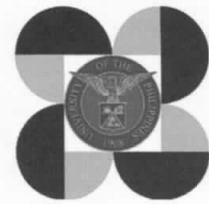

The contest is open to all senior high schools in the Philippines and will cover general science topics including logic, riddles, and mathematics.

MECHANICS

1. Each team will consist of **3 members** who have registered for the event as senior high school students of their respective schools.
2. Quiz questions will cover logical topics including **analogy, blood relations, clock, coding and decoding, directional sense, letter series, linear arrangement, number series, and riddles**. They may be multiple choice questions, identification, and enumeration.
3. Complaints regarding questions posed by the teams or their coaches must be presented to the Board of Arbiters before the next question is read.
4. The Board of Arbiters will be composed of science instructors from the University of the Philippines - Cebu. The decision of the Board of Arbiters is final.
5. Each question shall only be read twice. After the first announcement of a question, the contestants will be given their own copy of the questions by the proctors overseeing each team. After the question is repeated, they may write their answers on the boards provided.
6. Contestants will be provided with answering boards, chalk, erasers, and calculators by the organizers. Use of materials other than those provided shall be prohibited for the whole duration of the event.
7. The Quiz Bowl will consist of three rounds: easy, average and difficult. Each round will consist of ten questions, after which each team's scores for the round will be summed up and tallied.
8. Each round's questions will be allotted a corresponding time limit, afterwards, the contestants will be asked to raise their boards and present their answer. Failure to raise the board within the time limit will automatically disqualify the answer of the offending team for that item. Disqualified answers will not be given any corresponding points.
 - Easy round: **10 seconds**
 - Average round: **20 seconds**
 - Difficult round: **30 seconds**
9. Teams that have answered a question correctly will earn a corresponding amount of points.

The values are as follows:

 - Easy round: **1 point**
 - Average round: **3 points**
 - Difficult round: **5 points**
10. Two **diskarte questions** will be announced after each round which will be given 1 minute to answer. Each team will have 15 seconds to decide whether or not to answer the diskarte questions.
11. If the team gives a correct answer, they will gain twice the points allotted for that round. Otherwise, twice the points allotted for that round will be deducted from their total score.
12. If, after calculating the total score of the teams, two or more teams are tied at the rank of third place or above, the tied teams will undergo a clincher round where each team will answer clincher questions worth 5 points and will be allotted 30 seconds. The clincher round will have as many questions as the number of teams tied plus one.
