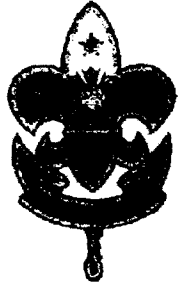

1. The Visayas Scouting Regions, Boy Scouts of the Philippines will conduct the following events:

**EVENT : 2019 NATIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM FOR VISAYAS AND REGIONAL SWA**

DATE : March 7-9, 2019

VENUE : Silay South Central School, Silay City

HOST : Negros Occidental Council

2. A. The Scout Youth Forum aims:

- To effectively communicate and discuss matters affecting themselves on the present issues and concerns;
- To provide feedbacks to governing bodies and the Boy Scouts of the Philippines on matters referred to them for discussion;
- To elect their Scout representative to the National Executive Board.

- B. The SWA aims to:

- Capacitate the young people with technical knowledge about the SWA Program;
- Give the young people an opportunity to explore and discover an issue faced by their respective communities;
- Allow the young people to respond they have discovered and its impacts to them and to the community through service projects that address the challenge;
- Startup the journey of the young people towards the attainment of the Scouts of the World Award.

3. **Theme:** This year's theme is "**Commitment to Excellence**"

4. **Participation:** Two (2) official voting delegates and two (2) observers per council to youth forum and at least 20 participants for SWA.

5. **Registration:** A registration fee of **ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P1,500.00)** shall be charged each participant to cover meals and snacks (from Breakfast of March 7 until Lunch of March 9, 2019), certificates, T-Shirt, forum and SWA materials, and other administrative expenses. Registration, Transportation and other incidental expenses shall be chargeable against local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**6. Qualifications:**

**Youth Forum**

- a) must be currently registered senior scouts
- b) must be a holder of at least Outdoorsman rank preferably Grade 9 or 10.
- c) must be elected official delegates at the Council Scout Youth Forum
- d) must be physically fit with parent consent.
- e) must be articulate and can participate in forum discussions.

**SWA**

- a) must be currently registered senior scouts
- b) must be a holder of at least Outdoorsman rank
- c) must be physically fit with parent consent.

1. All activities in SWA will be credited for advancement.
2. Attire: The forum and SWA delegates shall wear their Type A Uniform. It is suggested to bring along formal attire for socialization activity.

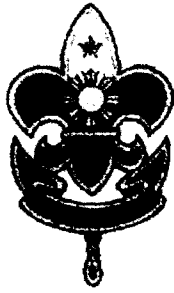
