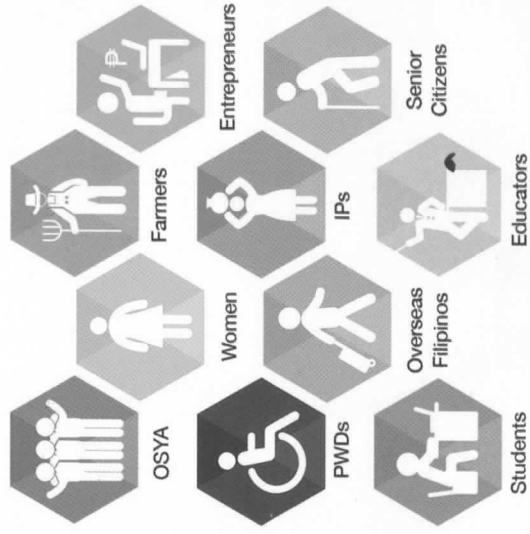

Who can establish a Tech4ED center?

Where can Tech4ED centers be established?




Ideally, Tech4ED centers should be where target customers can flock. Specifically in LGUs, FITS centers, public libraries, schools, cooperatives, barangay halls, associations of PWDs and/or senior citizen centers, among others.

How does one establish a Tech4ED center?

The Tech4ED centers' material requirements are, but not limited to:

- Office space – not smaller than 20sqm
- WiFi connectivity and router – at least 1 router
- Three (3) computers
- Three (3) computer tables with chair
- Three (3) tables and chairs (for users who will bring their own laptop)
- One (1) personnel
- SB resolution (Sangguniang Bayan)
- To follow the operating hours: M-F (1-9PM); Sat (9AM-5PM); Sun (12-5PM)
