The tricycle driver sensing of a possible head-on collision and to avoid it will happen swerved to the right, thus caused the victim accidentally fell from the tricycle, thereby causing head injury incurred by the victim. That at the time the tricycle driver was swerving to its right the victim was taking coins from her wallet for fare perhaps and was not holding on the vehicle.

That the tricycle driver immediately called the attention of the driver of an ambulance to transport his injured passenger (Catherine Catubig) to the nearest hospital.

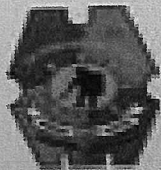

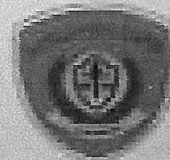
