- 1. Pursuant to the Regional Memorandum 0415 s. 2019 this office announces to conduct the Dengue Alert Response in Schools.
- 2. The Department of Health (DOH) declared a National Dengue Alert due to the rapid increase in the number of dengue cases nationwide in several regions. This calls for an **URGENT response** to all government agencies, including the Department of Education (DepEd) to address the health issue.
- 3. In this regard, emphasis of the urgency of the anti-dengue drive is of utmost importance in the Department of Education through the 4-S Strategy which stands for: Search and Destroy, Seek Early Consultation, Self- Protective Measures, and Say "NO" to indiscriminate fogging. Likewise, to protect the learners from mosquito bites while at school, wearing of light -colored pants is advised.
- 4. Furthermore, the following activities are requested: (a) Ensure compliance to the 4-S Strategy, (b) Enhance Dengue Awareness in Schools, (c) Coordinate with DOH and Rural Health Unit (RHU) for the installation of Insecticide-Treated Screens (ITS).
- 5. In this light, Schools Division Office through the Health Personnel and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Coordinators are requested to monitor closely the dengue outbreak in their localities. Please see attached communication for more of the details.
- 6. School officials are enjoined to support the anti-dengue awareness and initiatives.
- 7. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance to this Memorandum is highly desired.
