2ND CID CONFERENCE FOR SY 2019-2020

1. This Office announces the conduct of the **2nd Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Conference for SY 2019-2020** at Compostela National High School, Compostela, Cebu on September 12, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m to be hosted by Compostela District.
2. This conference aims to:
 - a. Consolidate the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (PHIL-IRI) and Early Grades Mathematics Assessment (EGMA) results;
 - b. orient PSDSs on the use of ALS Weekly Lesson Logs (WLLs), in lieu of Daily Lesson Plans (DLPs) and the conduct of Class Observation (CO) at the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Learning Centers (LCs);
 - c. discuss the details of DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 (Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities);
 - d. consolidate the Division Performance Indicators for the last three school years;
 - e. provide feedback on the GAD-based iC CEBU Pilot Test;
 - f. present updates on curriculum implementation by subject area/PPA, including SpEd and LRMDs;
 - g. benchmark on the host district's best practices on curriculum implementation; and
 - h. ensure proper flow of information and communication critical to the operational efficiency and effectiveness of the Curriculum Implementation Division.
3. Participants to this conference are the District Supervisors/OICs, CID and SGOD Education Program Supervisors (EPSVRs), Education Program Specialists II-ALS (EPSAs) and the CID and SGOD Chiefs.
4. PSDSs are required to bring the following to the conference:
 - a. soft and hard copies of the PHIL-IRI (Filipino and English) and EGMA results;
 - b. District Consolidated Comparative Performance Indicators for SY 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019;
 - c. Kindergarten to Grade 10, including SpEd enrolment data for SY 2019-2020 by school, grade level and sex (male and female);
 - d. Grades 11 and 12 enrolment data for SY 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 by school, grade level, sex, strand and TVL specialization;
 - e. ALS enrolment data for SY 2019-2020 by Learning Center, Level (Elementary and Secondary) and sex (male and female);
 - f. profile of ALS implementers (name, sex, item/position, designation (DALC or Mobile Teacher), contact number/s, email address/es and number of learners; and
 - g. duly accomplished GAD-based iC CEBU Lesson Exemplar (LE) Pilot Test monitoring template (for PSDSs of Pilot Districts only).

5. A representative from the host district is expected to deliver a 5 minute presentation of the districts best practices on curriculum implementation programs, projects and activities (PPAs).
6. Traveling expenses of EPSVRs, PSDSs and EPSAs, lunch, snacks, conference materials and other related expenses shall be chargeable against **Division MOOE Funds**, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. This Memornadum serves as participants' Authority to Travel.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.


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
