DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS (KFOT)

1. This Office announces the conduct of the **Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents (KFOT)** on **October 18, 2019** at **Daanbantayan Central School, Daanbantayan, Cebu**.
2. Participants to this activity are the **First Place Winners** of the Cluster-Level KFOT in the 13 contest categories. A District level KFOT shall be conducted prior to the conduct of the Cluster level KFOT.
3. The following are the schedules and venues for the different clusters as agreed upon during the Conference of the District Kindergarten Coordinators (DKCs) last August 29, 2019, viz:

Meals, travelling and other incidental expenses that may be incurred by the pupils, coaches, school heads and other school personnel relative to their attendance to the District, Cluster and Division levels KFOT shall be chargeable against **school MOOE/SEF/PTA funds**, while meals and travelling expenses of Division Supervisors shall be chargeable against **Division funds**, subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

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GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR JUDGING THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS KINDERGARTEN DAY 2019

Tema: Ang Bata nga Malipayon, Dali nga Makakat-on

1. VOCAL SOLO COMPETITION

1. Contestant can choose any age appropriate song for children which Maybe English, Filipino, or Visayan
2. Performance time is 3 – 5 minutes including entrance & exit.
3. Only minus-one music is allowed to be used for the competition.
4. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria;
 - **Voice quality and projection ----- 25%**
 - **Rhythm----- 15%**
 - **Dymanics ----- 15%**
 - **Diction ----- 15%**
 - **Mastery----- 20%**
 - **Showmanship----- 10%**
 - Total 100%**

2. DUET

1. Contestants are free to choose any song.
2. Performance time is 2 to 3 minutes including entrance and exit
3. Only minus-one music is allowed to be used for the competition.
4. The winners will be chosen by the Board of Judges based on the following criteria:
 - **Voice quality and projection-----25%**
 - **Rhythm----- 15%**
 - **Diction-----15%**
 - **Dymanics----- 15%**
 - **Mastery and Showmanship-----20%**
 - **Audience Appeal/Impact-----10%**
 - TOTAL 100%**

3. BALAK

1. Each contestant will recite the poem that revolves around the theme within 2 – 3 minutes
2. The poem (balak) must be in sinugbuanong binisaya.
3. The winner will be chosen based on the following criteria;
 - **Content/Relevance to the theme -----30%**
 - **Voice Clarity-----20%**
 - **Delivery----- 25%**
 - **Mastery-----25%**
 - TOTAL 100%**

4. FOLKDANCE - (ALITAPTAP- refer to grade 3 book for the literature)

Costume- rural *Note: Do not rely on youtube videos

1. The group is composed of 5 pairs/10 members
2. Time of performance should not exceed five (5) minutes including

entrance and exit.

3. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the following criteria

- Creativity-----25%
 - Choreography-----20%
 - Grace & Footwork----- 25%
 - Mastery & Coordination----- 25%
 - Attire-----5%
- TOTAL 100%

5. NURSERY RHYME RECITATION (ENGLISH)

1. Each contestant will recite a nursery rhyme of his/her choice.
2. Each contestant will be given 1- 2 minutes including entrance and exit
3. The winner will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- * Voice clarity and projection----- 25%
 - * Diction-----20%
 - * Expression and showmanship----- 25%
 - * Mastery ----- 20%
 - * Costume ----- 5%
 - * Audience Appeal/Impact----- 5%
- TOTAL 100%

6. CREATIVE DANCE COMPETITION

1. The group is composed of 3 pairs with a total of 6 members
2. Each group will create dance steps depicting a certain sport of their choice.
Example: if they choose basketball, their steps shall include dribbling, shooting, throwing, catching, etc
3. Time performance shall not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.
4. Props should be naturally placed on stage during the performance.
5. The winner will be chosen based on the following criteria;

- Creativity 25%
 - Choreography 20%
 - Grace and Footwork 25%
 - Mastery and coordination 20%
 - Attire/Costume 10%
- TOTAL 100%

7. MATHINIK (TANGRAM PUZZLES)

1. Contestant must bring 1 set with 7 geometric pieces (BASA Pilipinas tangram pieces). Silhouette tangram pieces (black 7 geometric pieces) must be prepared also by the contestant patterned from BASA Pilipinas tangram pieces.
2. Each will be tasked to arrange the tangrams based on the given figure.

3. There are 5 rounds to complete the activity. (3 colored BASA Pilipinas tangram pieces and 2 silhouette tangram pieces)
4. The contestants will be given 10 seconds to acquaint himself/herself of the given figure with 2 hands raised. (Figures must be presented through a multimedia projector)
5. He/she will be given 1 minute to arrange the puzzle pieces and will raise his/her 2 hands if done.
6. Contestant will be ranked according to the time they finished the task.
7. The contestant who will get the lowest composite rank will be declared as winner.
8. Participants who will go out from the contest room will be given 5 minutes to return before he/she will be declared DQ.

8. Mathinik (Arithmetic Wiz) This contest is intended for the mathematically inclined/advanced Learners.

1. There shall only be one (1) contestant.
2. The questions for this competition will be formulated from window card. -Addition -Subtraction
3. All participants will undergo the window card exam.
4. Each pupil will take the exam individually.
5. No coach, faculty, staff or representative from any school other than the participants will be allowed to enter the examination room before the exam.
6. Any questions during the exam should only be addressed to the proctors inside the room.
7. Calculators, cell phones or any gadgets will not be allowed inside the examination rooms.
8. Only answer sheets, pens and window cards provided are allowed to be used during the exam.
8. All contestants will be advised to take toilet breaks before the start of the exam. Once inside the room, pupils are not allowed to go out.
9. Emergency situations will be handled by the proctors.
10. Any form of cheating and intellectual dishonesty will result to the disqualification of the pupil.
11. The top three (3) pupils with the highest score and fastest time will win.
12. In case of a tie, the involved pupils will compete in a tie-breaker round to fill the remaining slots.

9 PICTURE READING

1. The contestant will be given 5 minutes for acquaintance with the pictures.
2. The picture story shall be delivered within 3 minutes.
3. The language to be used will be Mother Tongue.
4. The winners will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the general criteria below.

B. Projection

➤ Voice Mechanics	-	10%
➤ Level of Confidence	-	10%

➤ Accuracy	-	10%
➤ Automaticity	-	10%
➤ Prosody	-	10%

1. Each contestant will be given a copy of the pictures they will color using crayons.
2. Contestants will be provided with all the materials needed for the contest.
3. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
