TRAINING ON RONDALLA FOR MAPEH TEACHERS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, will conduct the Training on Rondalla for MAPEH Teachers on November 26-29, 2019 at Applied Nutrition Center, Banilad, Cebu City.
2. The program outcomes for the training include the following:
 - a. demonstrate musical and pedagogical knowledge and skills in solo/group rehearsal, performance, and in general music classroom experiences through rondalla music;
 - b. show appreciation to varied music genre as well as diverse forms of music culture in the Philippines through rondalla music; and
 - c. promote and preserve Filipino rondalla music through public performances and cultural shows.
3. The participants of the said training are the Division MAPEH Supervisors and the identified MAPEH teachers whose names are attached in enclosures 1 and 2 and are expected to bring materials and music equipment listed in enclosure 3.
4. Travelling and other incidental expenses of the participants are chargeable against school MOOE/local/PTA and other fund sources while expenses for board and lodging will be charged to OSEC-7-19-0233 subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. First meal is breakfast on November 26, 2019 and last meal is lunch on November 29, 2019. The training management team are expected to be at the venue on November 25, 2019 with breakfast as the first meal and should stay until dinner of November 29, 2019 for the post-evaluation.
