CONDUCT OF THE 2019 CEBU DIVISION SELECTION OF ATHLETES AND FINAL LIST OF OFFICIATING OFFICIALS

1. This Office announces the conduct of the 2019 Division Selection of Athletes which will be held on February 29 and March 1, 2020 to be hosted by different Districts and LGUs, namely:

Carmen : Athletics and Baseball (Elem and Sec)

Catmon: Badminton (Elem and Sec)

Compostela : Sepak Takraw, Table Tennis and Chess (Elem and Sec) Liloan : Futsal (Sec), Football and Volleyball (Elem and Sec)

Consolacion: Boxing and dance Sports (Elem and Sec)

Minglanilla : Arnis, Billiards, Taekwondo and Basketball (Elem and Sec)

Abellana : Swimming (Elem and Sec)

Balamban : Tennis, Softball, Wrestling and Wushu (Sec)

- 2. Division Manual of Operations containing the guidelines of the games, criteria in the selection of athletes, coaches and Officiating Officials which is Palarong Pambansa based shall be the implementing guide of all participating delegations/teams to ensure the smooth conduct of the 2019 selection of athletes.
- 3. Copy of the Norms and Standards of the Selection of Athletes, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Chaperones and Officiating Officials is enclosed for strict implementation and compliance among those involved during the selection games. (Enclosure 1). The final list of officiating officials will follow.
- 4. Public Schools District Supervisors of the host districts are advised to prepare the billeting quarters of the participating teams to the event/s assigned in your district for a safe and secure environment including the coordination with the respective local government units.
- 5. Ocular inspection of billeting quarters shall be conducted by the committee prior to the arrival of the participating teams to make necessary preparations. Athletes, coaches and officials are requested to provide their own sleeping needs. Attached is the scheduled activities. (Enclosure No. 2)

- 6. District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary School Heads should be responsible in assuring the attendance of all persons concerned in the performance of their assignment and ensure the successful conduct of the 2019 Division Selection of athletes. Any concern relative to the billeting should be properly addressed to District Supervisor of the Host Municipality.
- 7. As DepEd Oder No. 66, series 2017, Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-campus Activities states that:
 - a. uphold child protection principles and that no learner shall be disadvantaged in any form,
 - b. observe the safety and security protocols for all participants before, during and after the activity,
 - c. Vehicles, most especially those arranged with external transportation operators shall be duly certified by the Department of Transportation (DOTr)/ Land Transportation Office (LTO).

Vehicles shall strictly follow the traffic rules and related regulations as set by the law (ex. Speed limit, use of seatbelt, capacity, etc.) In cased where multiple vehicles are used during an off-campus activity, said vehicles shall always be in convoy.

- d. Drivers, the school shall ensure that all drivers assigned to service offcampus participants have updated licenses and are in good medical condition as per their latest health examination within a year of the scheduled activity.
- 8. All District MAPEH coordinators are directed to retrieve all the credentials of their athletes after a week of the final game at the Division Office except for those who will qualify to the Regional Meet. Credentials Committee Members and the Management Team will not be held accountable of any unclaimed/lost credentials.
- 9. Interview of athletes in all sports events shall be conducted by the Division Screening and Accreditation Committee (DSAC) Members starting February 28, 2020 in their respective billeting quarters.
- 10. Service Credits for teachers and CTO for non-teaching personnel shall be granted to those who render service on Saturday and Sunday. Tournament Managers are tasked to submit the attendance sheets and accomplished Daily Time Record to Dr. Gerardo S. Mantos right after the activity.
- 11. Expenses incurred by the participating teams in all activities relative to the selection of athletes such as transportation, meals, uniforms, insurance including expenses incurred the credential pre-screening and preliminary conferences and other related activities shall be chargeable against Local School MOOE/PTA/SEF or any available funds, subject to their availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 12. This Memorandum serves as Authority to Travel of the participants.
- 13. Immediate and widest dissemination of the Memorandum is directed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR COACHES AND ATHLETES

1. For safety purposes, all athletes, coaches, chaperones must wear their IDs in and outside the billeting quarter and in the playing venues.

Boxing

- 1. Coaches should provide their boxers with the following:
 - Gloves, Mouth Piece, bandage, head gear, groin protector, tips

Badminton/ Table Tennis

1. All players are expected to provide their own rackets.

Basketball

1. T-shirts with nos. 04-15; black - 10" H; front - 4 H

Chess

1. Chess players should bring their own chess boards and chess clocks. NO chess clock, NO play.

Football/ Futsal

- 1. Athletes t-shirts should bear numbers from 1-15 at the back.
- 2. Athletes must wear shoes during the game.

Sepak Takraw

1. Athletes must wear rubber shoes during the game.

Softball

1. Players must wear rubber/spike shoes when playing; t-shirts, nos. 01-12.

Taekwondo

1. Player must wear dobuk uniforms during the competition.

Norms and Standards of Conduct of Athletes, Coaches, Chaperones and Technical Officials

A. Athletes

- 1. Athletes are expected to observe the highest degree of respect and courtesy to coaches, officiating officials and management staff.
- 2. Athletes must maintain cleanliness and orderliness at the billeting quarters and their surroundings.
- 3. No athlete is allowed to stay away from the team.
- 4. Electric lights must be put off and water faucets must be closed when not in use.
- 5. Athletes must be in properly accepted uniforms/ attire during the games.
- 6. Athletes must observe punctuality during games and other activities in the meet.
- 7. All athletes should abide by all the rules and regulations of the games.
- 8. Any athlete caught under the influence of liquor or involved in the use of prohibited drugs before, during, and after the games shall not be allowed to play in any game during the meet.
- 9. Banning of athletes from participating in any school-based meet shall be imposed to athletes who violate any of the rules, the extent of which will depend on the gravity of the offense.
- 10. All athletes should take care of their belongings to protect them from losses. Bringing of valuables such as jewelry and the like is discouraged. Furthermore, clothes should not be hung at areas prone to theft.

B. COACHES, ASSISTANT COACHES, CHAPERONES, TRAINERS

- 1. Coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones and trainers are expected to respect authority of technical officials.
- 2. Decision of officiating officials must be respected.
- 3. Clarifications, queries, complaints, protests must be done in accordance to established rules and procedures with utmost courtesy.
- 4. Punctuality during the games shall be observed. Default and forfeiture shall be implemented in cases of tardiness in accordance to the agreed ground rules governing punctuality.
- 5. Decency and propriety must be observed in dressing during the games.

- 6. Gambling, drunkenness and drinking alcoholic beverages are prohibited all throughout the duration of the games.
- 7. Coaches and chaperones must ensure that cleanliness is maintained at the sleeping quarters.
- 8. Coaches and chaperones must ensure that the classrooms used as sleeping/billeting quarters are clean before leaving for home.
- 9. Austerity measures must be observed in the billeting quarters. Lights must be put off and water faucets closed when not in use.
- 10. The safety, welfare and discipline of the athletes should be the primary concern of coaches, chaperones and delegation officials.
- 11. All delegates should take care of their belongings to protect them from losses. Bringing of valuables such as jewelry and the like is discouraged. Furthermore, clothes should not be hung at areas prone to theft.
- 12. Any infraction to the above norms of conduct and behavior shall be dealt with administratively.
