

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) Regional Language Centre announces its scholarship program on "Certificate in English Teaching-Secondary (CELT-S)" and SEAMEO Research Fellowship for Fiscal Year 2020. This program is designed for English teachers working in secondary schools. It is a blended learning course that can be completed with formal assessment, leading to CELT-S qualification.

The programme will be conducted in four phases from 10 August 2020 to 28 February 2021. They are:

Rationale	CELT-S is a qualification designed for English language teachers working in secondary education (ages 11-18).
Aims	 CELT-S aims to help participants improve the quality of their classroom practice by: developing and extending teachers' knowledge and skills; focusing on the strategies, methods and materials teachers need to teach language effectively; helping teachers to manage and motivate large classes; and providing teachers with strategies to ensure that all learners achieve their potential.
Duration	CELT-S is a 150-hour blended learning course, comprising eight modules (see Course Syllabus for details) and a practical component (comprising portfolio tasks and teaching observations).
Period and Nature of Study	 CELT-S will be conducted in four phases. They are: Phase 1: 10 August to 1 November 2020 12-week online learning phase (with at least 40 hours of online study) Phase 2: 3 to 27 November 2020 4-week residential training in Singapore at SEAMEO RELC (with 84 hours of face-to-face study, *TP1: 6 hours of micro-teaching and peer observation and TKT (Module 1) which will be taken on Fri, 27 Nov 2020 in Singapore. Phase 3: 7 December 2020 to 31 January 2021 8-week online learning phase (with at least 20 hours of online study) Phase 4: 10 February to 17 February 2021 or 17 February to 24 February 2021 (exact dates to be confirmed by RELC trainer and the hosting schools) 1-week on-site visit and teaching observations (*TP2 & *TP3) by RELC trainer

 - A multiple-choice teaching knowledge test (TKT Module 1) to be taken at an authorized test centre in Phase 2

Course Award

Course participants who complete all the modules and assessments will receive the CELT-S qualification from Cambridge Assessment English and a Certificate for TKT (Module 1).

GUIDELINES FOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

1 RELC will offer at least one Research Fellowship in the year 2020 to the region.

The intent of the SEAMEO RELC Research Fellowship is to:

- promote research capacity in the region in studies relevant to the development of language education in the region;
- enhance the quality of research efforts in a relevant or related area of language education, to attain international recognition and understanding; and
- foster rigour in research efforts through sharing and discussion.
- Applications for Research Fellowships will be considered by RELC in the light of such priorities as may be established, and of the availability of funds, but especially in the light of the probable value of the project for the development of language education in a SEAMEO member country or in the SEAMEO region.
- 3 The admission requirements for the Research Fellowships are as follows:
 - a) Applicants must be nationals of SEAMEO member countries;
 - Applicants must possess a rich background in research with a good number of research articles that have been published in English by international language and linguistics journal(s);
 - c) The research project or proposal put forward must be sound, feasible and relevant to language and/ or education;
 - Application reflects ability to analyse, explain and write cogently;
 and
 - e) Applicants must possess a Doctoral degree in Linguistics, Applied Linguistics, TESOL, English Language, Education, or Training. Applicants without the equivalent academic qualifications could be considered, strictly on the merit of their known and published research work and experience, in English, backed by a solid curriculum vitae of project leadership and research involvement.

RELC reserves the right to make the final decision in the selection and award of the Research Fellowships.

Applicants are expected to be capable of independent work on their proposed research projects. The proposed research project must not be part of or associated with any research project intended for a university degree or for meeting the requirements of a non-RELC grant or award.

- The period of research may stretch up to six months, with the last one month to be on attachment at RELC. Research Fellows from outside Singapore will be provided with return airfares (economy class), accommodation at the RELC International Hotel, and an allowance of \$\$600 during the one-month attachment. The Research Budget (excluding airfare, accommodation and allowance in Singapore) should not exceed \$\$1,500.
- The proposed research project must not be started and no expenses are to be incurred until the outcome of application is made known to the applicant that the research fellowship award has been awarded.
- 7 RELC Research Fellows will have available to them all the relevant resources of the Centre, including one of the finest specialist libraries for research in linguistics and language teaching and consultancy, and advisory services of highly qualified academic and research staff.
- Research Fellows will be required to present their research findings at a staff seminar during the period of attachment at RELC and submit a copy of the research project at the end of the attachment period. The report of the research project should be at least 8,000 words in the form of a journal article. The journal article shall first be submitted to the RELC Journal for consideration of publication. In the event that RELC does not wish to take up the publication of the journal article, it may then be submitted to other journals of linguistics or language education for publication.
- In accordance with the established policy of RELC, all copyright in the report of the research project shall belong to RELC and the Research Fellow shall execute and deliver the necessary documents required to transfer the copyright in the report of the research project to RELC.
- 10 Persons applying for RELC Research Fellowships are required to submit research project proposals for evaluation and approval. Information on the proposed research project should be as specific and detailed as possible. All proposals must include a budget and all costs should be stated in Singapore dollars. The award does not provide for the payment of honoraria.
- 11 Payment of expenses will be on a reimbursement basis upon presentation of invoices/receipts, while on attachment at RELC and upon submission of the completed research project.
- There are no specific deadlines for applications for the Research Fellowships. Quality applications will be considered throughout the year. For interested applicants, please complete the application form (Annex E) and submit it to us via your respective Ministries.

GUIDELINES FOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS

1 RELC will offer at least one Research Fellowship in the year 2020 to the region.

The intent of the SEAMEO RELC Research Fellowship is to:

- promote research capacity in the region in studies relevant to the development of language education in the region;
- enhance the quality of research efforts in a relevant or related area of language education, to attain international recognition and understanding; and
- foster rigour in research efforts through sharing and discussion.
- Applications for Research Fellowships will be considered by RELC in the light of such priorities as may be established, and of the availability of funds, but especially in the light of the probable value of the project for the development of language education in a SEAMEO member country or in the SEAMEO region.
- 3 The admission requirements for the Research Fellowships are as follows:
 - a) Applicants must be nationals of SEAMEO member countries;
 - Applicants must possess a rich background in research with a good number of research articles that have been published in English by international language and linguistics journal(s);
 - c) The research project or proposal put forward must be sound, feasible and relevant to language and/ or education;
 - Application reflects ability to analyse, explain and write cogently; and
 - e) Applicants must possess a Doctoral degree in Linguistics, Applied Linguistics, TESOL, English Language, Education, or Training. Applicants without the equivalent academic qualifications could be considered, strictly on the merit of their known and published research work and experience, in English, backed by a solid curriculum vitae of project leadership and research involvement.

RELC reserves the right to make the final decision in the selection and award of the Research Fellowships.

4 Applicants are expected to be capable of independent work on their proposed research projects. The proposed research project must not be part of or associated with any research project intended for a university degree or for meeting the requirements of a non-RELC grant or award.

- The period of research may stretch up to six months, with the last one month to be on attachment at RELC. Research Fellows from outside Singapore will be provided with return airfares (economy class), accommodation at the RELC International Hotel, and an allowance of S\$600 during the one-month attachment. The Research Budget (excluding airfare, accommodation and allowance in Singapore) should not exceed S\$1,500.
- The proposed research project must not be started and no expenses are to be incurred until the outcome of application is made known to the applicant that the research fellowship award has been awarded.
- 7 RELC Research Fellows will have available to them all the relevant resources of the Centre, including one of the finest specialist libraries for research in linguistics and language teaching and consultancy, and advisory services of highly qualified academic and research staff.
- Research Fellows will be required to present their research findings at a staff seminar during the period of attachment at RELC and submit a copy of the research project at the end of the attachment period. The report of the research project should be at least 8,000 words in the form of a journal article. The journal article shall first be submitted to the RELC Journal for consideration of publication. In the event that RELC does not wish to take up the publication of the journal article, it may then be submitted to other journals of linguistics or language education for publication.
- In accordance with the established policy of RELC, all copyright in the report of the research project shall belong to RELC and the Research Fellow shall execute and deliver the necessary documents required to transfer the copyright in the report of the research project to RELC.
- Persons applying for RELC Research Fellowships are required to submit research project proposals for evaluation and approval. Information on the proposed research project should be as specific and detailed as possible. All proposals must include a budget and all costs should be stated in Singapore dollars. The award does not provide for the payment of honoraria.
- 11 Payment of expenses will be on a reimbursement basis upon presentation of invoices/receipts, while on attachment at RELC and upon submission of the completed research project.
- There are no specific deadlines for applications for the Research Fellowships. Quality applications will be considered throughout the year. For interested applicants, please complete the application form (Annex E) and submit it to us via your respective Ministries.
