GUIDELINES RELATIVE TO THE CONDUCT OF THE END-OF-SCHOOL-YEAR RITES

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has issued DepED Order No. 002, s. 2020, entitled "Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of the K to 12 Basic Education Program End-of-School-Year Rites (EOSY)", relative to the procedures adopted to meet the curriculum requirements at the end of the school year and in consideration with the emerging health issue of the country.
- 2. As part of the implementation of DepED Order No. 002, s. 2020 and in consultation with the Schools Division Superintendents, the following shall be adopted by DepEd Region 7:

Graduation Rites	 All SDOs within the week of April 13-17, 2020 except City of Naga Division with no graduation following the City Executive Order No. 88, s. 2020 "Declaring the Cancellation of Graduation Rites, Recognition and Moving Up Ceremonies and All other Related Activities From Pre School to Post Graduate Levels".
	 Safety measures will be observed consistent with the DOH guidelines.
	 Depending on the health situation, the schools in consultation with the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA) may choose to reschedule or forego the holding of the graduation.
Administration of the National Examinations	As scheduled but for SDOs with suspension of classes will have to submit a report to the RO.
Final Examinations	Administered as soon as the suspension is lifted.

Reporting teachers to from March April 3, 2020		•	Teachers are not required to report to schools but required to finish all the academic requirements of the learners and submit the required year end reports.
